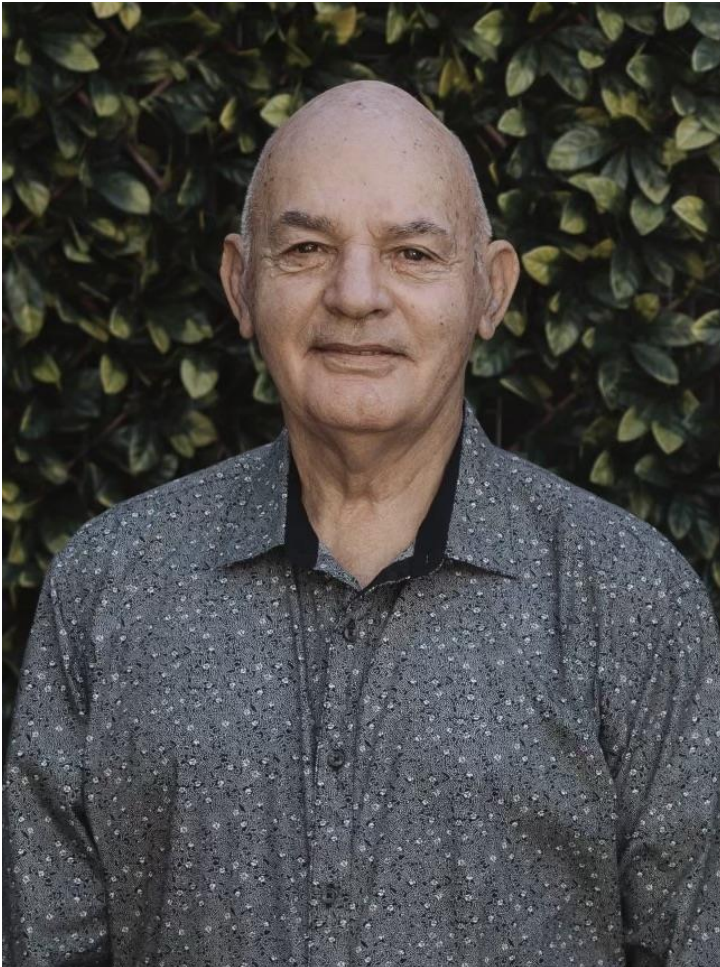


Sadly we'd like to acknowledge the passing of Ian Carter, a longtime resident here at Kismet, after a short battle with cancer.
